Painting outside can be challenging. Bugs, sun, and wind can be overcome by slapping on bug juice and sun screen and going out on a calm day. Nature's complexity, though, remains. Together we will explore how to simplify and paint outdoor scenes.

SUPPLY LIST

Subject Reference Materials: Photographs and visual references of outdoor scenes, in case weather keeps us inside. Otherwise, bring appropriate outdoor gear (a long sleeve shirt, hat, sun glasses, sunscreen, and outdoor painting equipment). We will meet at the Creative Element store, good weather or bad.

Drawing Materials: An 8.5 by 11 inch sketchbook, a No. 2 school pencil, and a white eraser.

Watercolor Paper: One full sheet (22 by 30 inches) of Arches 140 lb. cold press watercolor paper.

Support Board (or stout cardboard): Approximately 13 by 17 inches on which to tape 11 by 15 inch (quarter sheet) watercolor paper.

Brushes: A one-inch flat watercolor brush and a # 8, 10, or 12 round watercolor brush. An inexpensive but good quality brand is Simply Simmons.

Watercolor Paints: The following artist quality tube watercolor paints or their equivalents: Aureolin Yellow, Cadmium Red Light (the orange), Quinacridone Rose (the red), Ultramarine Violet (the purple), Phthalocyanine Blue, and Viridian (the green). If you already have these tube colors, don't buy new ones.

Palette: I use the Quiller Traveler Palette so I can quickly refer to the color wheel as I paint. Your palette should have an ample mixing area. I will help you place your paints, if you buy a new palette.

Plastic Water Container: Holding a quart of water. **Masking Tape:** Three-quarter to one-inch wide.

Paper Towels.

Plastic Tablecloth: To cover tables.
