Subject Reference Materials: Photographs or magazine pictures of simple subjects that fill the page.

Drawing materials: Inexpensive 8 1/2 by 11 inch paper, a No. 2 school pencil, and an eraser.

Watercolor paper: One full sheet (22 by 30 inches) of Arches 140-lb. cold press.

Board (or stout cardboard): Approximately 13 by 17 inches on which to tape the watercolor paper.

Miscellaneous Supplies: Pencils, charcoal, crayons, pastels, pens, watercolors in a palette, acrylic tubes, acrylic mediums such as gel medium and varnish, a white mixing plate for the acrylics.

Other supplies: Magazines to tear up. old watercolors to rip up, interesting fabric, scissors, scrapers, palette knives, and other texture-making supplies.

Brushes: One-inch flat synthetic watercolor brush, and a #8, 10, or 12 synthetic round brush.

<u>Water Container:</u> Holding at least a quart of water. <u>Masking Tape:</u> Three-quarters or one inch wide.
