Learn how to combine transparent and opaque watercolors in this workshop. Watercolors create transparent, suggestive passages while gouache introduces translucent and opaque passages.

SUPPLY LIST

Subject Reference Materials: Photographs or cut-out pictures from magazines or calendars showing interesting landscape scenes. Do not bring paintings done by other artists.

Drawing materials: Inexpensive 8 1/2 by 11 inch paper, No. 2 school pencil, and white eraser.

Watercolor paper: One full sheet (22 by 30 inches) of Arches 140-lb. cold press.

Board (or stout cardboard): Approximately 13 by 17 inches on which to tape small pieces of watercolor paper. **Brushes:** One-inch flat and # 10 round watercolor brushes. Simply Simmons brushes are inexpensive. **Paints:** Artist quality tube transparent watercolor paints of the following colors or their equivalents: Aureolin Yellow, Cadmium Red Light (the orange), Quinacridone Rose (the red), Ultramarine Violet (the purple), Phthalocyanine Blue, and Viridian (the green). A tube of Titanium White gouache (M. Graham makes quality gouache paints.)

Palette: A white plastic palette with plenty of mixing area. Water Container: Holding at least a quart of water. Masking Tape: Three-quarters or an inch wide. Paper Towels. Plastic Tablecloth to cover the tables.
