# Paints, Paint Brushes and Tools. Need to add a little something extra into an artists' life?



**Catalyst Painting Tools**: Silicone tools to add texture. Many shapes and sizes. Push around paint, clay...even cake icing!

**Koi Travel Set**: 18 or 24 pans of color with a waterbrush in a travel case...under \$30.00.

**Masking Fluid**: Keeps areas of your painting white until you are ready. Check out the Daniel Smith detail masking pen.

**Watercolor Blocks**: Take a pad of watercolor paper and glue the edges. Keeps your paper tighter as you paint. Many different sizes. Also available in smooth (hot-press) surfaces.

Brush-O: Powdered watercolors. As fun & loose as you think they are

So last year you bought a ton of colored pencils, now...

...you have a lot of little pencil pieces left over, you need a:

Pencil Extender. Use up all those elf-sized pencil pieces.

...your finished work looks a tiny bit uneven & rough, you could us a:

Colorless Blender. Smooth out and blend your colors.

...your pencils are rolling on the floor and stab your feet, you really need a:

Pencil Holder. Roll-ups, folders and cases. Hold 24 to 120 pencils at a time!



Mixed-Media Pads. Paper for drawing and colored-pencils, but built to take watercolors, paints, markers anything an artist wants.
